

**Where Did I Come From, Where Am I Going?
One-on-One Swedish Research Consultation Information
Friday, 26 March 2010, 4:00-8:30 pm**

Kathy Meade, the North American representative for *Genline: Swedish Genealogy Online*, www.genline.com will be available for 30-minute consultations to help persons who have questions regarding Swedish genealogy. Have Swedish roots, but don't know where to begin? Reached some road blocks in your Swedish research and want tips on how to continue? Want tips on how to find the parish where your ancestor came from? Kathy will provide tips on how to proceed with your research.

Kathy has been the North American Representative for six years and volunteers at the Swedish American Museum in Chicago and the Arlington Heights Memorial Library in Arlington Heights, Illinois assisting persons with their Swedish genealogical research. Prior to working for Genline, Kathy worked for a multinational company in the information technology sector for over 20 years and worked and lived in Sweden and Norway for six years where she learned Swedish and Norwegian.

At the consultation, Kathy will have access to online databases as well as various CDs. Among the tools that she will have access to include:

- Emibas CD – Names of 1.1 million emigrants who left Sweden between 1840 and 1930
- Emigranten CD – Passenger ship list indexes of passengers leaving Swedish ports between 1869 and 1950
- 1890, 1900 and 1980 Swedish Census
- Swedish Death Index 1947 – 2006
- Genline

Please fill out the form and be sure to describe exactly what you wish to determine. Include what you know such as name, birth date, emigration date, names of siblings, parents' names and places that you think your ancestor may have lived. You may also include further information on additional paper but please keep it 'reasonable'. Also, do not include original documents.
