### **IMPORTANT!**

The City of Alexandria is an independent municipality and not a part of Fairfax County. Since the series Fairfax County, Virginia Cemeteries covers only those cemeteries within the confines of the county, cemeteries which lie within the city limits of Alexandria are not included.

An area of Fairfax County just south of the city limits of Alexandria is known as "South Alexandria." Cemeteries in this area of the county are included in the South Alexandria section.

Nearly all of the cemeteries and private burial grounds that were once within the current city limits of Alexandria have been catalogued and researched by Wesley E. Pippenger, of Arlington, Virginia. In his four-volume series *Tombstone Inscriptions of Alexandria, Virginia,* Mr. Pippenger gives detailed information about 36 separate burial locations. This series is available from Family Line Publications, Westminster, Maryland.
